

GOATS

RULES

1. Goat classes open to the province of Quebec.
2. Entry forms including applicable fees and certificate of insurance must be in the office of the secretary by August 10th, before 8:00 p.m. The post mark will not be considered.
3. A **\$25 exhibitor's fee** must accompany each entry form plus **\$10 entry fee per animal**. \$5 of the entry fee per animal will be refunded when prize money is paid, if animal shows on judging day.
4. All animals must be on the grounds by Thursday at noon and must remain on grounds until 6:00 p.m. Monday. All substitutions must be made before 1:00 p.m. Thursday.
5. Original registration papers must be available at show time for **all animals twenty-four months of age and older**. All purebred animals must be legibly tattooed.
6. American, British, Canadian and purebred may be shown in the same class.
7. All exhibitors must wear white to show their animals.
8. The maximum total eligible exhibits from a breeding unit are fifteen. An exhibitor may place these fifteen in the appropriate classes. No limit per class.
9. During judging only the judge, the Brome Fair goat committee members and the exhibitors will be permitted in the judging enclosure.
10. Judging Sunday 9:30 a.m
11. All exhibitors must present their animals on Sunday parade. All exhibitors must wear white on parade.

Prizes for purebred goats in each class

Prizes for grade goats in each class

1. **Doe kid**
Age as of September 1st, 2009, over three months and under nine months.
2. **Doe kid**
Age as of September 1st, 2009, over nine months and under twenty-four months, never freshened.
3. **Junior Champion Doe**
Chosen from classes 1&2.
4. **Milking yearling**
Over twelve months and under twenty-four months, in milk

5. **Doe**
Over twenty-four months and under thirty-six months, in milk.
6. **Doe**
Over thirty-six months, in milk.
7. **Doe**
Over sixty months, in milk.
8. **Champion Doe**
Chosen from classes 4, 5, 6 & 7.
9. **Grande Champion Doe**
Chosen from classes 3 & 8
10. **Breeders Herd:** A group of four animals owned by the exhibitor consisting of at least two milking does.
11. **Best udder class:** Judge shall designate the best two udders in each of the milking classes. These designated exhibits shall compete for the first and second best udder. Prize money on first and second placing only.

The following classes apply to section:
657 Dairy goat specials

Trophies and ribbons only

1. **Champion junior inter-race**
2. **Best udder**, all sections.
3. **Mother and daughter**, all sections.
4. **Get-of-Sire**, all sections.
5. **Best doe in show**, the best doe in the show will be chosen from the grand champion does of all sections All grand champions must compete.

The following classes apply to section:
658 Meat goats

Prizes for the following classes
\$22, \$20, \$18, \$15, \$12

1. Eleven months or less
2. Twelve to twenty-three months
3. Two years and over

The following classes apply to section:
659 Angora goats

All Championship Classes are Ribbon Classes only

Prizes for the following classes
\$45, \$40, \$35, \$30, \$25

1. **Buck kid**, born 2009.
2. **Buck yearling**, born 2008
3. **Junior Champion Buck**, chosen from classes 1 & 2
4. **Adult Buck**, born 2007 or later
5. **Grand Champion Buck**, chosen from class 4
6. **Doe Kid**, born 2009
7. **Doe Yearling**, born 2008
8. **Junior Champion Doe**, chosen from classes 6 & 7

9. **Adult Doe**, born 2007 or later

10. **Grand Champion Doe**, chosen from class 9

11. **Breeders herd**, group of four animals owned by exhibitor, both sexes must be present

12. **Get-of-Sire**, three animals from the same sire, but not including the sire. Both sexes must be represented. Ribbon class only

13. **Progeny of dam**, dam and two offspring of either sex. Ribbon class only

Section 660 : Competition for Herdsman

This competition is open to any herdsman or owner-exhibitor showing a minimum of five animals in the dairy or meat goat classes. (\$40, \$30, \$20, \$10)

Basis of the award

For the best display of dairy or meat goats, not including the quality of the goats themselves. At least fifty percent to be allotted for general neatness of the exhibit and for grooming of the goats. The remaining fifty percent to include courtesy of the herdsman and information provided to the public as well as other factors to be determined by the goat committee. Judging will take into account all factors involved in an all-day operation of Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
