

# GOATS

## RULES

---

1. Entry forms including applicable fees and certificate of insurance must be in the office of the administration by August 10<sup>th</sup>, before 8:00 p.m. The post mark is not considered.
2. A **\$25 exhibitor's** fee must accompany each entry form plus \$20 entry fee per animal. The \$20 the entry fee per animal will be refunded when prize money is paid, if animal shows on judging day.
3. All animals must be on the grounds by Thursday at noon and must remain on grounds until 6:00 p.m. Monday. All substitutions must be made Thursday upon verification.
4. Ages of the animals will be considered as of the show date
5. The maximum total eligible exhibits from a breeding unit are fifteen. An exhibitor may place these fifteen in the appropriate classes. No limit per class.
6. All exhibitors must present their animals on Sunday parade. All exhibitors must wear show colours.
7. During judging only the judge, the Brome Fair goat committee members and the exhibitors will be permitted in the judging enclosure.
8. Judging Sunday 9:00 a.m.
9. All Championship classes are Ribbon only classes.
10. Section 660: Competition for Herdsman  
This competition is open to any herdsman or owner-exhibitor showing a minimum of five animals in the dairy or meat goat classes. (\$40, \$30, \$20, \$10). All exhibitors are considered for this competition.  
Basis of the award: For the best display of goats, not including the quality of the goats themselves. At least fifty percent to be allotted for general neatness of the exhibit and for grooming of the goats. The remaining fifty percent to include courtesy of the herdsman and information provided to the public as well as other factors to be determined by the goat committee. Judging will take into account all factors involved in an all-day operation of Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday 7am. to 10p.m.

## DAIRY CLASSES

---

- All exhibitors must wear white to show their animals.
- Original registration papers must be available at show time for all animals twenty-four months of age and older. All purebred animals must be legibly tattooed.
- American, British, Canadian and purebred may be shown in the same class.

**651** *Nubian*

**655** *Grade Goats*  
**656** *All other pure breeds*

**Prizes for purebred goats in each class**

\$45, \$40, \$35, \$30, \$25

**Prizes for grade goats in each class**

\$20, \$18, \$16, \$14, \$12

1. **Doe kid:** Age as of September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011, over three months and under nine months.

2. **Doe kid:** Age as of September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011, over nine months and under twenty-four months, never freshened.  
**Junior Champion Doe:** Chosen from classes 1 & 2.
3. **Milking yearling:** Over twelve months and under twenty-four months, in milk
4. **Doe:** Over twenty-four months and under thirty-six months, in milk.
5. **Doe:** Over thirty-six months, in milk.
6. **Champion Doe:** Chosen from classes 4, 5 & 6.
7. **Grand Champion Doe:** Chosen from classes 3 & 7
8. **Breeders Herd:** A group of 4 animals owned by the exhibitor consisting of at least 2 milking does.
9. **Best udder class:** Best 2 udders in each milking class. Designated exhibits shall compete for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> best udder. Prize money on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placing only.

## MEAT CLASSES

---

- All exhibitors must wear black trousers and a white shirt to show their animals.
- RECBQ rules shall govern.
- Original registration papers must be available at show time for all animals. All purebred animals must be legibly tattooed.
- All group classes of a division must be made up only of those animals that have been shown in the individual (age) classes of that division of that particular show.
- Doe kids participating in classes 1 to 4 must never have kidded.
- Any doe born in 2010 that has kidded will be shown in class 6.
- Does participating in classes 6 to 9 must have kidded.
- Exhibitors may only register once per group class.

### Purebred Doe

1. Doe kid born from March 1, 2011 to June 30, 2011
2. Doe kid born from November 1, 2010 to February 28, 2011
3. Doe kid born from July 1, 2010 to October 31, 2010
4. Doe kid born from November 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010
5. **Junior Champion:**  
Chosen from first place winners of classes 1, 2, 3 & 4  
**Reserve Junior Champion:**  
Chosen from those remaining in Junior Champion class as well as the animal that stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual class
6. Doe under 3 years born in 2009
7. Doe 3 years born in 2008
8. Doe 4 years born in 2007
9. Doe 4 years and older, born before 2007
10. **Senior Champion:**  
Chosen from first place winners of classes 6, 7, 8 & 9  
**Reserve Senior Champion:**  
Chosen from those remaining in Senior Champion class as well as the animal that stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual class

**11. Grand Champion:**

Junior Champion and Senior Champion compete

**Reserve Grand Champion:**

Chosen from the remaining Champion as well as the animal that stood Reserve Champion to the Grand Champion winner in its section

**Purebred Buck**

12. Buck kid born from March 1, 2011 to June 30, 2011

13. Buck kid born from November 1, 2010 to February 28, 2011

14. Buck kid born from July 1, 2010 to October 31, 2010

15. Buck kid born from November 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010

**16. Junior Champion:**

Chosen from first place winners of classes 12, 13, 14 and 15

**Reserve Junior Champion:**

Chosen from those remaining in Junior Champion class as well as the animal that stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual class

17. Buck 2 years born from November 1, 2008 to October 31, 2009

18. Buck 3 years born before November 1, 2008

**19. Senior Champion:**

Chosen from first place winners of classes 17 and 18

**Reserve Senior Champion:**

Chosen from those remaining in Senior Champion class as well as the animal that stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual class

**20. Grand Champion:**

Junior Champion and Senior Champion compete

**Reserve Grand Champion:**

Chosen from the remaining Champion as well as the animal that stood Reserve Champion to the Grand Champion winner in its section

**Group**

21. Produce of Dam: 3 animals produced by the same doe.

22. Get of Sire: 2 animals sired by the same buck.

23. Exhibitor's Herd: 1 male and 3 females

**Section 660 : Competition for Herdsman**

This competition is open to any herdsman or owner-exhibitor showing a minimum of five animals in the goat classes. (\$40, \$30, \$20, \$10)

**Basis of the award**

For the best display of dairy or meat goats, not including the quality of the goats themselves. At least fifty percent to be allotted for general neatness of the exhibit and for grooming of the goats. The remaining fifty percent to include courtesy of the herdsman and information provided to the public as well as other factors to be determined by the goat committee. Judging will take into account all factors involved in an all-day operation of Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
