The aims are:

1. To encourage organized boys' and girls' club work in the district.
2. To improve educational value of the Fair.
3. To develop better farmers and breeders.
4. Stimulate the interest of young people in the Fair and through them to interest a greater number of adults.

RULES

1. Contestants must be between the ages of eight and twenty-five years inclusively as of January 1 the current year. Peewee class – ages five, six, and seven, years accepted.
2. Each contestant must complete a current BCAS entry form with all required information by August 10th or they will not be permitted to show.
3. The judging competition will begin immediately after the parade on Sunday.
4. The Committee shall not be responsible for any articles lost or stolen, sickness or other accidents that may happen to the contestants during their stay at the fair.
5. All up to date health regulations must be adhered to.
6. Animals may be grade or pure bred.
7. **Attire:** Dairy & goats: white; Beef: breed colors; Sheep: white shirt, black pants.
8. All trophies must be returned to the fairgrounds office not later than August 10th, before 8:00p.m. and must be engraved and cleaned, ready for display. Presentation will be made immediately after judging is completed.
9. **Showmanship to be judged on the following basis:**
 - a) Condition of calf, horse, sheep, goat, cleanliness, training, fitness.
 - b) Presentation in the ring, showing manners with suitable halter, (rope or leather).
 - c) Contestant appropriately attired for the show ring.
10. **Regulations for those showing calves:**
 - a) The Fair Board reserves the right to cancel the Inter-club classes should less than three clubs make entries in these classes.
 - b) All calves must be on the grounds by 9:00 a.m. Monday. All entries will be accepted unless notified.
 - c) Hay and bedding will be supplied. Members are requested to bring any other requirements.
 - d) Club members must show the same calf all season.
 - e) All exhibitors must be paid members of a recognized calf club, 4-H, Q.Y.F, or Jeunes Ruraux.
 - f) Minimum of three calves of each breed to constitute a class or at the discretion of the 4-H Committee.
